Annual Assessments

❑ **MASTER ASSOCIATION** – All property owners are assessed \$400 per year by The Village at Nags Head Property Owner’s Association to maintain landscaping at main entrances, traffic islands, two soundside piers, and private ocean park with bath house.

❑ **COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS** – Community associations typically provide maintenance for lawns, common areas and dumpster sites, with reserves set aside for future road repair in the respective neighborhood.
