Discover the hidden Outer Banks

It's a safe guess that most Outer Banks visitors are here for the spectacular beaches of this sandbar by the seathe warm sun, the soft sand and cool refreshing waters of the Atlantic Ocean.

But there is so much more to the Outer Banks than the beach. Less than a mile

from the surf there is a world of maritime forests filled with towering pine trees, ancient live oak and birds of every description. There's a lot to explore and more than we can list, but here are three great places to get started.

School. Located to the left or east side of the road, there is a small parking area with a map kiosk 20 yards or so from the highway.

There are a number of sandy dirt roads throughout Buxton Woods, making it perfect for a four-wheel drive tour. The

> roads also offer an easy way to explore on foot.

The trails through the forest, though, are fascinating and worth the effort of hiking them.

At the end of Old Doctor's Road, Lookout Loop Trail is a moderately challenging but short hike. A couple of places on the trail look out over the ridges and valleys.

For a more challenging trail, check out the North Trail which is off Water Association Road. The trail climbs over relict (ancient remnant) dunes,

then plunges into valleys. The trail connects with quite a number of other Buxton Woods trails, making longer hikes very possible with this one.

Nags Head Woods

There's a good possibility that at one point in time for any Nags Head Woods hiker on the Sweet Gum Trail the question will be asked, "Am I in the mountains?" Climbing steeply up the side of a series of relict sand dunes, the ridges are heavily forested with hardwood trees,

giving the hard-packed dirt of the trail a distinctly alpine feel.

But in the distance, there is the everpresent sound of the ocean, and soon enough the trail descends to the forest floor where verdant marsh and beautiful freshwater ponds dominate.

For hikers looking for a more challenging hike, the combined Sweet Gum Swamp Trail and Blueberry Ridge Trail is a five-mile trek over a variety of terrain.

Most of the trails are much easier, though.

The Center Trail is a quarter-mile trail that is perfect for little legs. There is also a half-mile ADA-compliant trail that circles an impoundment teeming with yellow-bellied slider turtles and a regular home to green heron, great blue herons and great egrets.

A fascinating and fairly easy trail is the Roanoke Trail. The trail winds its way through what was once the Tillett family homestead and history markers lining the trail tell the story of the Tillett family.

The trails are strictly off limits for mountain bike riders, but Old Nags Head Road is a sand- and hard-packed dirt road that gives a little bit of a challenge in a beautiful setting.

There is a parking lot at Ocean Acres Drive that offers the best access to all of the trails of the preserve.

Sandy Run Park

Tucked away on the Woods Road in Kitty Hawk, Sandy Run Park may be the most beautiful small park on the Outer Banks. A Kitty Hawk Town Park, this little gem offers an extraordinary opportunity to experience the beauty and diversity of a maritime forest in a very easily navigated half mile loop trail.

This park is ideal for anyone of any age.

Parents with toddlers—or even a bit older—looking for something that will

keep the kids fascinated for hours? Take some lettuce (preferred) or bread and drop pieces in the water and watch as the yellow-bellied sliders swarm to the food. If there is a huge turtle in the mix with a somewhat square shaped head, it's probably a snapping turtle. Snapping turtles are actually very gentle—just don't dangle your fingers in front of their mouths.

Spring to the end of September, there has been a nesting pair of osprey in one of the tall pine trees along the side closest to the Woods Road. Any time of the year, pay attention to the sounds of birds in the trees then look up a see if there is a palliated woodpecker around—they have a very loud caw, caw, caw cry.

Or maybe there's a red-winged blackbird in the reeds or perched on the branch of a dead tree. And in the waters, wading birds, great blue heron, great egrets and green heron are common.

There are also squirrels, an occasional raccoon, a nutria—an invasive, destructive rodent from South America—from time to time, and it is a habitat that muskrat would like, but none have been seen.

The park is also a catch and release fishing site. Another plus for the location.
